Bio:

Marcus Lundberg (*1995) is a composer born in Alingsås and currently residing in Gothenburg, Sweden. He studied composition at Ingesund School of Music in Värmland (with Christofer Elgh), and The Academy of Music and Drama in Gothenburg (with Malin Bång, Esaias Järnegard and Ole Lützow-Holm). In 2022, he began his master studies in experimental composition in Gothenburg. Lundberg works with subtle explorations of timbre, pitch and silence, often through sparse and delicate soundscapes. With an affinity for quiet sounds, he composes music which does not seek to impose itself, but rather that makes space for the self, and invites the listener to listen inwards. He writes mostly for acoustic instruments, and has worked with ensembles such as Norrbotten NEO, Curious Chamber Players, 40f, Gothenburg Wind Orchestra and Musica Vitae. In 2022, Lundberg was selected to participate in the composition academy at Kalvfestivalen, with Pierluigi Billone and Klaus Lang. He was appointed 'Young Swedish Composer of 2023' by Scenkonst Sörmland. Lundberg is a board member of Levande Musik in Gothenburg.
